So, what is a smart meter?

A smart meter is a digital electric meter that sends your usage data directly to NB Power over a secure wireless network—so there is no need for manual meter readings. You can think of it like this: A smart meter is to a traditional meter what a smart phone is to a regular telephone. They both do the basics, but the smart version gives you more tools and helpful insights.

Smart meters offer many customer benefits, such as online tools to help you track and understand your electricity use, which may help you lower your monthly bills. In the long term, smart meters will help us detect outages faster and restore power more quickly. Because they enable so many service improvements, smart meters are now the standard for over 80% of Canadians.

Why are we upgrading the grid?

We are upgrading New Brunswick's electrical grid to make it more reliable and better prepared for the future. As more people add electric vehicles or solar panels to their homes, we need a smarter grid to support these changes. Just as important is making sure that you—our customers—feel heard, respected, and supported throughout this change. That's what this series is all about.
